



Q: When is the vote for amalgamation?

A: The vote will take place on **Sunday November 4th** at both Christ Church and First United.

Q: Who can vote?

A: You must be a member to vote. Non-members and adherents are not eligible to vote.

Q: Can I become a member before the vote?

A: Yes, Christ Church will have reception of new members on November 4th.

Q: How will the voting take place?

A: Both Christ Church and First United will use a secret ballot system.

Q: What if I am not able to attend or out of town on Sunday November 4?

A: Christ Church members who cannot attend the meeting can participate by telephone conference calling.

- Call the Conference Call number **416-472-5080** or a toll free # **1-877-323-2005** (North America only). The Conference Call automated responder will ask you to enter a code to join the call.
- Enter the code **7480905** followed by the # sign and you will be connected.
- Please call in no later than **11:15 AM (Meeting Start time)**
- Following the meeting, you can submit your vote.

Q: Has Presbytery approved the amalgamation?

A: Presbytery has been kept in the loop about the planning for amalgamation and is comfortable with the plans. All Presbytery requirements have been met. Presbytery is aware of the November 4 vote and will be informed of the vote results. If the vote is positive, a motion will go to Presbytery for their approval at their November 13th meeting.

Q: Can I ask questions before the vote on November 4th?

A: Christ Church members can attend a Question & Answer session on **Sunday October 28th** at 10:00 AM in the Merigold Room and after the 10:30 service in the Sanctuary.
