ARTISAN/VENDOR INFORMATION

The 10th Annual Treats 'n' Treasures Christmas Marketplace will be held Saturday, November 16, 2019 from 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Christ First Church, 1700 Mazo Cres., Mississauga, ON L5J 1Y8 (corner of Clarkson Road North and Truscott Drive). This event combines the former First United Christmas Marketplace and Christ Church Treats 'n' Treasures, following the amalgamation of the two church congregations.

Table rental is \$55 for a 6 foot table and \$100 for a 12 foot table. There is an extra charge if you require an electrical outlet or wall space. *We do not take a percentage of vendors' profits nor do we ask you to donate an item for our raffle/auction.* All profits go to the life and work of the congregation, supporting a variety of community and global projects. Shoppers will be charged a \$3 entry fee which entitles them to coffee/tea and a muffin; all entry fees collected will be donated to The Compass.

New for some artisans/vendors, this year, we will be asking all, including returning artisans/vendors, to submit an application along with photos of your work. This is a juried event and the committee will select artisans/vendors to ensure the highest quality and most diverse selection for our shoppers. Thank you for your understanding. The popularity of this event continues to grow and, for a few years now, we have had line-ups before the doors open. As we only use the auditorium of the church, we have a limited number of vendor tables. **We suggest you apply without delay!** *Items made by hand will be given preference.* Please see the Artisan/Vendor Application form for deadlines and other information.

If you are a successful applicant, you will receive further information about your table in late October or early November. Please note, we do have WiFi which you can use if you use a portable credit card device.

The church operates several tables: Baking and Preserves, Bazaar (items crafted and donated by members), Auction/raffle and gently used Christmas décor. We also have a Cafe which offers muffins, beverages and soup.
